This Song is my deliberate, bardic intent to redress that deficiency, to give the story a little depth, and poignancy, and gravitas, to enhance our understanding of the motives and inter-relationships between pagan and deity. This neopagan story is one that (figuratively) would have been told by a bard, sitting in a long house, or round a fire some 2000 or so years ago. His audience would be hunters, warriors and farmers, ancient Celts, anywhere in western Europe. The two main characters are the Horned God, called Cernunnos, or Herne; and the Goddess. Herne is a manly man, a hunter, a leader, who is a god of all the wild things of the earth. He's also both the Goddess son, and her husband.
