Theodore Parker was born 24 August, 1810, in Massachusetts, where his father was a small farmer. At the age of seventeen he began teaching in a school in order to procure the means of getting himself a college education. On graduating at the University of Harvard, he became in 1837 minister of the Unitarian Church at Roxbury. He removed to Boston in 1845, where he ministered to a large congregation for fourteen years. He also lectured all over the United States. He laboured for peace, temperance, and education; and still more ardently for the abolition of slavery. He became prostrated by over-work before he was fifty years of age. In 1858 he visited Europe in the hope of regaining his health; but in vain. He wrote home: My life is slowly dragging to an end. I have sought to teach the true idea of man; of God; of religion, with its truths, its duties, its joys. I have gone into the battle of the nineteenth century and followed the flag of Humanity. He died...
